**WHEREAS** Council received a request from Glacier North to expand the Brandt Quarry (NW22-24-4E) and Howardville Quarry (NE21-24-4E);

**AND WHEREAS** Glacier North is request the following permission;

- Expand the quarry facing both sides of Road 21E closer to the road allowance;
- The rock face to start 30ft from the shoulder of the road with a berm between the road and the quarry face;
- To build the berms starting 5 meters from the existing road edge towards the quarry face;
- Berms will be built according to Mines Branch specifications;
- Expansion on the east side would start 20 meters south of the driveway into the Brandt Quarry to point in line with ITM co-ordinate 14U 0642294/5611787;
- Expansion on the west side would start 20 meters south of the driveway into Howardville Quarry to driveway marker 141088;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** Council grant the approve as requested by Glacier North;  
**AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT** Public Works Manager inspect all the construction associated with the expansion and indicate any culvert installation that maybe required for drainage requirements.


